- ❖ Women activists empowered and engaged in political decision-making bodies and skilled in defending and promoting women's rights in democracy building.
- ❖ A common set of tools, methods and elements of discourse in order to promote gender equality as a priority on the political agendas.
- ❖ Multi-stakeholders dialogue launched with transitional institutions and political decision-makers.

The on-going conflict in Syria and high level of violence imposed even more limitations to civil organizing. IFE-EFI strives to contribute to a non-violent political transition in Syria by supporting a civil society platform that promotes gender equality and women's rights as central to democracy and constitution building.

Non –violent Transition

- **Diverse spaces and channels for dialogue favoring mutual understanding on women's rights and democracy building**

Women's Rights and Democracy

The program supports the work of women's rights and civil rights activists in advocating for **immediate stop of violence and for a peaceful transition towards democracy** in order to ensure that women's rights and gender equality are not left out of the transitional agendas.

It also supports the work of the Syrian women's rights and civil rights organizations in building a constitutional reform process inclusive of women's rights and gender equality.

The program enables the creation of spaces where women's rights organizations can engage in dialogue with stakeholders, in order to lobby for their project and elaborate the link between women's rights and democracy building. Multiple spaces enable further cooperation among women's rights organizations and with other parts of the democratic movement.
