

INCLUSIVOICE : YOUTH FOR CHANGE

The **InclusiVoice project** brings together the Center for Peace of Forlì, EuroMed Feminist Initiative (EFI) and the Women's NGOs Cooperation Network of Latvia. It aims to strengthen young people's participation in civic life through the creation of a campaign to raise awareness about violence against women and femicides in Europe. It aligns with the priorities of the **Erasmus+ program** for youth, particularly inclusion and diversity, gender equality, and democratic participation.

The project is based on two main objectives:

- Implement an innovative and inclusive **youth training programme** from the 12th to the 19th of April in Forlì, Italy, focused on nonviolence, gender equality, and civic engagement. It will combine theoretical sessions, group exercises, and practical simulations to equip participants with the knowledge and skills needed to understand and employ nonviolent direct-action strategies and for implementing awareness initiatives on femicides.
- Design and launch a youth-led **European awareness campaign** about violence against women and femicides in the three countries by the NGOs and the trained youth participants, from April to November 2026.

The campaign is built on key principles:

- Apply an **intersectional, multi-sectoral and human rights-based approach** in efforts to raise awareness on violence against women.
- Honour and **acknowledge women's movements** and their leadership in preventing and ending violence against women.
- Elevate the **voices of young feminists**.
- **Challenge social indifference** and encourage **collective responsibility** in addressing gender-based violence.
