

Study visit for the exchange of experiences and best practices between Algerian and Tunisian partners.

25 – 27 November 2025

EuroMed Feminist Initiative (EFI) organized a study visit to Tunis from 25 to 27 November 2025 for Algerian association representatives and experts, as part of an exchange of experiences and best practices aimed at supporting women's economic participation in Algeria.

Adopting a comparative and regional perspective, this study visit aimed to foster knowledge exchange by enabling participants to draw on the best practices and lessons learned by Tunisian civil society organizations (CSOs) in implementing strategies and mechanisms to strengthen and promote women's economic participation and employability. It also sought to enhance participants' capacities in advocacy, feminist leadership, and regional cooperation.

Over the course of the three days, Algerian participants met with various Tunisian civil society actors, including feminist organizations engaged in promoting women's economic participation. They had the opportunity to explore concrete initiatives supporting women's economic inclusion, as well as relevant research and legal frameworks. Discussions covered a wide range of themes, from literacy and social entrepreneurship to economic empowerment and employability. Algerian participants and Tunisian organizations also exchanged on the common challenges they face and the strategies implemented to address them.

The study visit concluded on a hopeful note. Algerian participants expressed their sorority with Tunisian organizations and emphasized the importance of sustainable cooperation, regional solidarity, and joint initiatives between organizations in Algeria and Tunisia. The strong commitment demonstrated by Tunisian organizations served as a major source of inspiration, while the connections built throughout the visit reaffirmed the essential role of civil society in defending the rights of women and girls, particularly in promoting their economic participation.
